

Q1 - You are being asked to participate in a research study conducted by Associate Professor Eric Willey, Milner Library, Illinois State University, and Susan Radovsky, Metadata Management Program Assistant, Harvard Library, Harvard University. Your participation in this study is voluntary. You will not be penalized if you choose to skip parts of the study, not participate, or withdraw from the study at any time. What would you do? If you choose to participate in this study, you will take a brief online survey about the creation (if any) of Wikidata items related to materials published in your journal, why you do or do not create Wikidata items, if your journal is currently publishing new content, and information about your journal's open access status. In total, your involvement in this study will last approximately 5-10 minutes. Are any risks expected? We do not anticipate any risks beyond those that would occur in everyday life. However, if you feel any discomfort, please stop answering the questions. Will your

information be protected? Your responses will be anonymous; nothing that will identify you will be linked to your responses. The findings from this study may be presented in journal articles and presentations at professional conferences in aggregate form. Who will benefit from this study? There is no immediate benefit to you from participating in this study. However, this study will benefit the Wikidata user and development community and scholarly journal publishers by helping them identify current usage of Wikidata by LIS journal publishers, and help identify how they might work together for their mutual benefit in the future. 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









apply)?





Q11 - Who is creating Wikidata items for materials in your journal (select all that apply)?







